Program Overview

We are pleased to announce that the third statewide conference of the Clinical Ethics Network of North Carolina, "Conundrums in Clinical Ethics Consultation: Consciousness, Capacity, and Compulsion." This event will take place on Friday, February 24, 2017, at the Conference Center of Novant Health Forsyth Medical Center in Winston-Salem, North Carolina. This full-day conference will feature both large and small group sessions on leading topics in clinical ethics.

Objectives

Conference speakers will examine multiple issues in caring for patients whose decision-making capacity is compromised or absent, including:

- Diagnosis of permanent vegetative state, minimally conscious state, and death by neurologic criteria.
- Treatment choices for unconscious and minimally conscious patients.
- Criteria for assessment of decision-making capacity.
- Caring for patients whose conditions limit their freedom of choice and action.
